

Maria Luisa Meneghetti was born in Venice (11 December 1950).

Education

She obtained a degree *cum laude* in Romance Philology at the University of Padua (June 1973).

Employment

Until 2021 she was Full Professor of Romance Philology at the Università degli Studi of Milan. She taught also at the Universities of Padua and Pavia, at the Università della Tuscia and at the University of Siena. From 2001 to 2004 she was Director of the *Dottorato europeo in Filologia romanza* (Universities of Milan, Pavia, Siena, Paris IV-Sorbonne, Santiago de Compostela, Zürich). From 2004 to 2011 she was Head of the PhD School *Scuola di Dottorato europeo in Filologia romanza*, which continued the previous PhD program, with the participation of the above-mentioned institutions and IUSS (Istituto Universitario di Studi Superiori) of Pavia, Collège de France and Fondazione Ezio Franceschini (Florence).

Research and Works

She works on Anglo-Norman historiography, French and Spanish *chansons de geste*, european courtly romance, troubadours and early romance poetry (Spanish, Portuguese and Italian), the relationship between literary themes and the visual arts in the Middle Ages.
