

INTERNATIONAL PRIZE OF THE FOUNDATION "UNIONE DELLE FONDAZIONI LINCEE" NAMED AFTER «EUGENIO MORELLI» FOR 2026

REGULATIONS

Art. 1 (Nature of the Prize)

The Foundation "Unione delle Fondazioni Lincee", named after "Eugenio Morelli" and established at the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei, in order to honour the memory of Senator Prof. Eugenio Morelli, shall award, every two years, an International Prize of € 10,000 (gross of applicable taxes), for studies in pneumology, understood as encompassing, in addition to pure science, the medical and surgical clinic.

Art. 2

(Terms and Conditions for Submission of Nominations)

The Prize shall be awarded without competition, based upon nominations submitted by Members of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei and by Presidents and Members of major Italian and foreign Academies.

Nominations, preferably accompanied by a brief profile of the candidate, a curriculum vitae, a comprehensive supporting statement, and a list of publications, must be submitted by e-mail exclusively to: ufficio.premi@lincei.it no later than 6:00 p.m. on 30 November 2025 (the date of dispatch of the e-mail shall be deemed valid). Should the deadline coincide with an Italian public holiday, it shall be extended to the first subsequent working day.

Nominations sent to addresses other than the one indicated above, even if pertaining to the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei, shall not be accepted.

Art, 3 (Selection Committee)

The Committee responsible for awarding the Prize shall be composed of five members, appointed by the Presidential Council, of whom at least three shall be chosen from among Members of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei and two shall be Clinicians. The right to propose the names of the two Clinicians shall belong to the founders of the Foundation for the duration of their lifetime and, thereafter, to the Accademia dei Lincei itself.

Members submitting nominations may not serve on the selection Committee.

The Prize may not be awarded ex aequo.

Members of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei are not eligible to receive the Prize.

The Committee may also propose not to award the Prize.

Should the Prize not be awarded, it shall automatically be re-advertised for the following year.

Art. 4 (Outcome)

The recommendation of the Committee regarding the awarding of the Prize shall be submitted for approval to the Class of Physical, Mathematical and Natural Sciences and, subsequently, for final approval to the Joint Classes of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei.

Art. 5 (Awarding)

The Prize shall be conferred during the Opening Ceremony of the Academic Year 2026–2027, in November 2026.
