THE INTERNATIONAL "GIUSEPPE E PAOLO GATTO" PRIZE 2020 (*)

CALL FOR NOMINATION

The Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei seeks nominations for the 2020 «Giuseppe and Paolo Gatto» International Prize for young Italian and foreign scholars who have achieved significant results in the following fields of research: 1) Venice, its lagoon, the hinterland and the coastlines from a geological, physical, biological and hydraulic point of view; 2) The Alpine chain and the Po Valley in relation to the Northern Apennines in terms of basic geological sciences and their applications in the geological environmental field. The Prize is award in the two fields on a rotation basis.

The amount of the prize is \in 2.500 (gross amount before tax deductions).

In 2020, the Prize will be awarded in following topic: Venice, its lagoon, the hinterland and the coastlines from a geological, physical, biological and hydraulic point of view.

Both Italian citizens and Foreign citizens may participate in the call, provided that the candidate is under the age of 35 when submitting the application. No exceptions will be made with regards to the age limit. Full professors are not eligible for the Prize.

Those who wish to participate in the call should send to the Awards and Scholarships Office of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei – via della Lungara, 10 – 00165 Roma, no later than **31 December 2019** (postmark deadline), the following material (including a CD or USB pen-drive with the files):

- 1. a letter requesting to participate in the call;
- 2. a copy of unpublished or published works from 2014 to present. Works that have already been awarded prizes will not be admitted;
- 3. other titles considered useful for the selection process;
- 4. a signed list of all the documentation (for publications include the title, publisher and year of publication);
- 5. a signed copy of *curriculum vitae et studiorum*.

The applicant must also include a declaration stating his/her personal information (date and place of birth; citizenship).

The application cannot be presented in person to the Awards and Scholarships Office of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei.

All documents will remain in the official records of the Academy for 12 months. The candidates may request the return of their publications/reprints (point 1 mentioned above) at his/her own expense, within 12 months from the conferment of the Prize.

The Prize winner will be selected by a Committee, appointed by the Accademia dei Lincei Class of Physical, Mathematics and Natural Sciences, composed of five members, including at least three members from the Accademia dei Lincei.

The Committee's proposal of the prize winner shall be submitted to the Class of Physical, Mathematical and Natural Sciences and subsequently at the Academy's Assembly Meeting for final approval.

The Prize cannot be shared, unless the work that is being presented has been produced by two or more scholars.

The Prize winner will be announced on the website of the Accademia dei Lincei – www.lincei.it.

The Prize will be awarded in June 2020 during the Academy's closing ceremony of the academic year.
