### **AIM OF THE CONFERENCE**

The aim of the Conference is to present the actual state of the art of Archaeometry and relative

prospects of development in the field of research and conservation. within the countries of the European Community (EC).

Co-operation among European countries is of particular importance to spread new archaeometrical techniques, to reinforce the necessary links between art and science and to optimise the processes of conservation and safeguard of Europe's cultural heritage.

Scientists from European countries more specifically involved in the problems of conservation and restoration will give invited lectures on these topics. The lectures will be published in the Conference Proceedings. A general discussion involving all participants will take place after each lecture.

A round table on "Progress in scientific methods for solving problems in research concerning the Cultural Heritage" will conclude the Conference.

Before the end of the Conference, short papers (no more than 5 typewritten pages, including figures) on the above mentioned topics can be submitted by participants to the Scientific Committee for publication in the Proceedings.
